### **Kent venue needed for SEBA's Ministerial Recognition Committee:**

We are looking for a church in Kent, to be willing and able to host the East panel of the Ministerial Recognition Committee. The Ministerial Recognition Committee, for those who don't know, interview those applying for Ministry training & oversee those who are in early stages of their Ministry.

The East panel meet 3 times a year, on either the first, or second Thursday of January, May & September.
