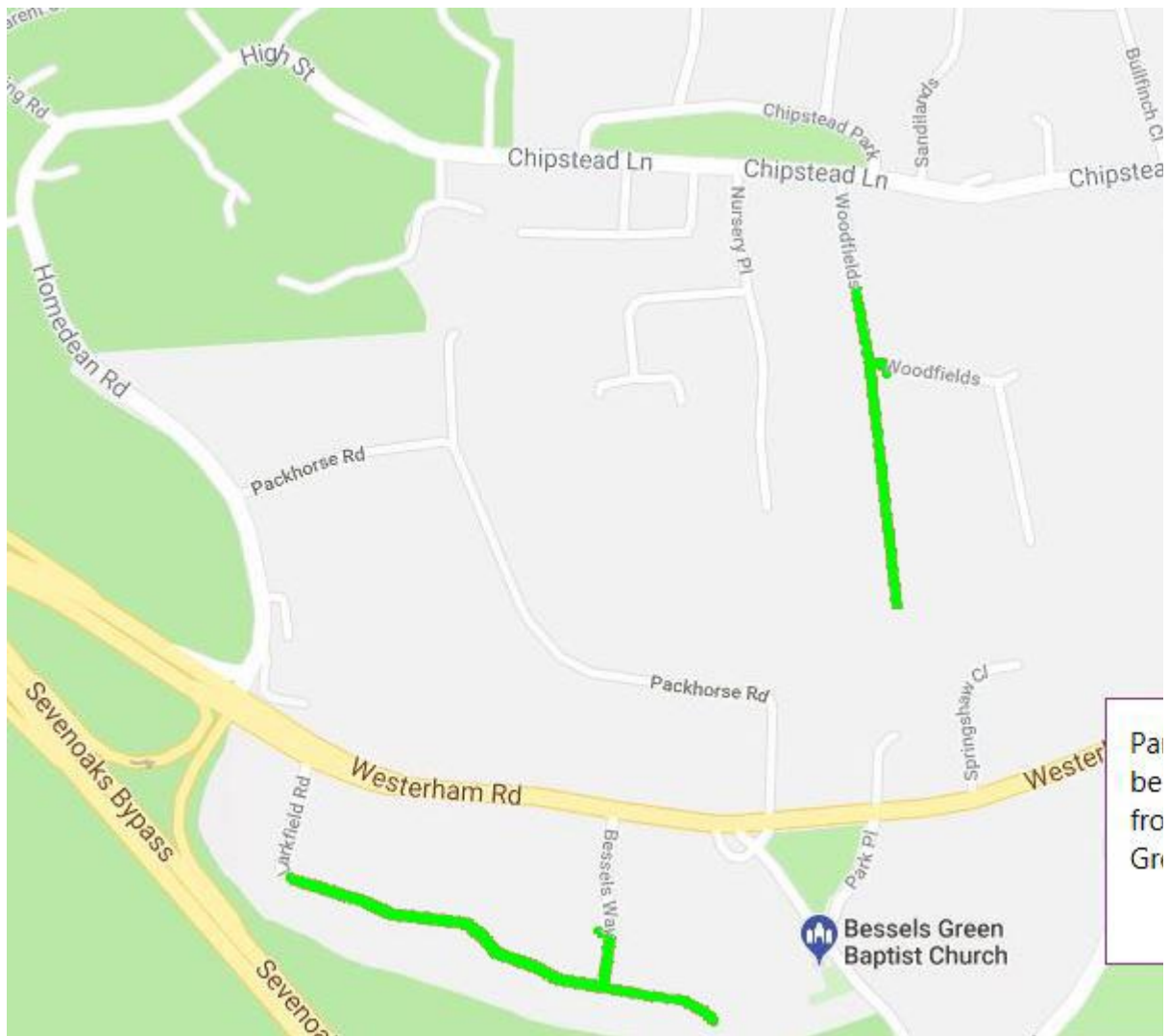
There will be an opportunity on the day to make a donation in memory of Brian
