The construction stage for Casa Neemia is now substantially complete and we start on the process of obtaining the final approvals. Those temporary residents who have been helping with trying out the facilities and helping with its maintenance will be considered for longer term accommodation and we will be looking to find the right people to occupy the remaining rooms. We need to define some expectations and house rules, and establish a longer-term management structure for the house.

Preparations are under way for this year's camp which is to be held during the period 18<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> June. Once again the campers will be enjoying the facilities at Camp Cristia near to the famous Voronet monastery. Some 40 children will be chosen from amongst our beneficiary families, together with a few more from 'church' families to show them the ropes whilst five leaders will, hopefully, keep them in order. Groups from elsewhere in Romania also attend the camp at the same time and this allows all the children to learn something about areas that they may not be familiar with. Once again, we are grateful to our supporters in south Wales who have provided the majority of the sponsorship for this holiday.

This week we will be exploring an opportunity to further publicise the needs in this part of Romania. We have had an offer of video expertise to illustrate not only our work but also the spiritual needs that our present workload precludes us from addressing adequately.

In addition to these special activities our normal work continues, with the distribution of aid, visiting our beneficiaries and helping people in difficult circumstances. This can only continue through the support that we receive and once again we pass on the thanks of all those who benefit from the generosity of our supporters.
